Each year, U.Va. students must turn down valuable internship opportunities because of financial constraints. Recognizing the importance of experiential learning and many of its associated high costs, the **Z** Society has endowed this internship scholarship, named in honor of past U. Va. Alumni Association Director Gilbert ("Gilly") Sullivan.

The Gilbert J. Sullivan Scholarship awards \$3,711 to a returning University undergraduate student. The scholarship intends to provide an opportunity for students to take a summer internship otherwise unattainable because of financial constraints. Priority will be given to applicants with a demonstrated financial need. Students should apply regardless of their citizenship status. We encourage those from marginalized communities and intersections of identity to apply.
